INCENTIVES

Minnesota offers a 25% transferable tax credit.

- Qualified minimum spend of \$1 million.
- Annual cap is \$25 million, but there is no per-project cap.
- Unused annual credits roll forward into the next year.
- A portion of both above and below the line non-resident compensation qualifies.
- As the home of major corporations like Target, US Bank, General Mills, 3M, and many more, Minnesota has a market for state tax credits, should you choose to transfer.
- Plus, we have regional rebates that can be stacked on top of the tax credit.



EXPERIENCED CREW AND TALENT

Minnesota crew are seasoned union (IATSE, Teamsters, DGA) and non-union professionals who work in film, television and commercials. From feature films and independent projects to national DIY and documentary unscripted series, our crews and production professionals have the experience to support any production.




